# Important Youth Camp Info

This policy is designed to insure safety and respect for all who attend summer youth camp, on and off the campus of the Timber Bay Camp and Retreat Center. Our vision is to introduce Jesus to those who don't know Him and to deepen the knowledge and relationship of those who do.

We strive to provide a safe and healthy environment, which promotes interaction with each other, growth in character and an attitude of service. We think the following expectations will serve as a means to help accomplish this vision. We desire relational growth and the movement of the Holy Spirit to change lives in Jesus name!

## **Camper Expectations:**

- Treat adults and other campers with respect. Treat camp property and other's property/belongings with respect.
- Remain in areas of camp buildings and campgrounds designated as "open" to youth.
- Refrain from inappropriate touch or gestures toward others.
- Active participation in group activities and programs.
- Do not bring tobacco products, alcohol, or other drugs on camp property or in vehicles/on bus.
- Represent your youth group by displaying Christian values and behaviors.
- Cell phones will be left at home or collected during registration before getting on the bus.
- Stay in cabins in the morning until released by adult leader for breakfast.

## **Disrespectful Behaviors:**

- Talking during singing, worship, teaching or when others are speaking.
- Refusing to follow directions of youth leaders when asked.
- Refusal to participate in games or other structured activities.
- Being outside of the designated building while a youth group meeting is in progress, unless supervised.
- Public display of affection or making sexual advances towards another.
- Inappropriate physical contact such as roughhousing, wrestling, or fighting.
- Use of electronic devices during times when they are not allowed.

## **Consequences of Disrespectful Behavior:**

- Camper will be taken aside and talked to regarding their behavior.
- If disrespectful behavior continues, Camper will sit out of activities.
- If disrespectful behavior continues or escalates, parents will be contacted to come pick up their child at the parent's expense. The camper will be expected to explain to their parents why they were called.
- If students choose to leave the camp premises, their parents will be contacted immediately by phone.

## **Adult Leaders Expectations:**

- Will strive to continue to grow in our walk with Christ and provide a safe, non-threatening environment.
- Camp Directors will have cell phones if Camper needs to contact parents.
- To be fair, firm, consistent and loving in the enforcement of this policy, realizing that not all disruptive actions are willful disobedience, but could be the result of some inner conflict. We are here to help. We will do our best to discern between the two.
- Any time a student needs to be taken from the room, he/she will be accompanied by two adult leaders.

## **Money for traveling to and from camp or extra money while at camp**

# Important Youth Camp Info

Bring money (\$30-40) for two meal stops in Hinkley, on the way to and from camp. Campers can also bring money for the Timber Bay Camp Store that will be open Friday morning before we leave. Campers can buy Timber Bay T-shirts (about \$20), Sweatshirts (about \$50) and other items. Campers will turn their money into their Adult Cabin Leader upon arrival at camp, if not prior. Money will be kept in a secure place until given back to Campers Friday morning.

## **Camper with special needs**

If camper has any special or specific individual needs, please let us know before camp. If necessary, tell us about diet, family situations, etc. All information is kept private; information is only shared with the staff and leaders involved. Pertinent information can be shared on the “Youth Camp Registration Form”, or by emailing or calling the Camp Director.

## **Camper with consistent prescription medication**

A licensed medical professional permitted to administer medication and perform medical services will always be on duty. All prescription medications need to be sent to in this manner:

1. Place medication (in its original container/packaging) in a zip lock bag.
  - a. Prescription medication must have a pharmacy label matching the child's name.
  - b. Enclose instructions on how and when to administer.
  - c. Directions from the doctor are enclosed and/or printed on the container.
2. Indicate proper storage of the medication (i.e. refrigeration) and whether the medication is “as needed” or “daily”.
3. Only send enough medication for the length of camp.
4. For multiple medications: Enclose each medication in a separate zip lock bag if needed.
5. Medications need to be turned in to the camp medical professional upon arrival at church/check-in.
  - a. For camp safety reasons, students are not allowed to administer their own medication.

## **Pain relievers or other over-the-counter medication**

Over-the-counter medications are available and can be given if deemed necessary by the camp medical professional, unless otherwise noted on the registration form. Please do not bring any over-the-counter medications, as they cannot be in cabins and need to be administered through the medical professional.

## **Adequate adults and supervision**

We take this seriously and plan for and provide superior supervision and safety. Each cabin has at least one counselor. There are also kitchen staff, directors, lifeguards, and various assistants providing guidance, direction, and safety. All adult leaders have a background check and take a child safety class.

## **Managing teenage boy and girl interactions**

Boys and girls are NEVER allowed to be in each other’s cabins. In addition, PDA is not allowed. Friendships are encouraged, but not relationships. Public/communal spaces are supervised by adults.

## **Behavioral Discipline**

1st time: verbal warning; 2nd time: miss activity; 3rd time: sent to Camp Director for a conversation. Continued behavior may result in dismissal from camp. Campers possessing weapons, alcoholic beverages, or illegal drugs will be sent home from camp immediately at parental expense. Campers who are exceedingly disruptive, destructive or a danger to themselves or others will be sent home at parental expense.
